- 7.2 Club Boat Hire Policy Recommendation by the committee to rescind the current Hire Policy with the view to selling some of the Club boats and only retaining a Laser and a Pacer and to purchase a couple of Opti's for Learn to sail programme.
- 7.3 Overview of 2016/2017 Sailing Programme Series racing will have more races for each series with a different course to be set for each series. Idea is to have some longer races and a varied course type.

Also there is to be a make up Regatta to be held on 23rd and 24th October to make up for the loss of the Anzac Regatta earlier in the year.

The Committee decided to not hold a dual regatta running concurrently (eg: when a public holiday is gazetted for a Tuesday or Thursday) as it is too difficult to get volunteers to run races on the Friday or Monday due to work commitments.

- 7.4 Shade Sails proposal. Would it be more beneficial to have something using a more permanent material that then could have some marquee type walls added to make the area more hireable. Cost would be greater to the club but income generated may offset the cost. All agreed that this was a good idea.
- 7.5 Radio Controlled Yachting is holding a National Titles Championship series in September and that there is a possibility of having a sailing stream that could include Radio Control Yachting at the Club. Amendment proposed to the Membership fee Structure to include a membership for Radio Controlled Yachts. Fee to be set at \$45- Social membership + ARYA Affiliation Fee.
